



WHAT WILL MY EDUCATION COST?

Before applying for financial aid, students and parents should assess all of the costs of attending this institution. The financial aid office establishes standard budgets, which reflect average costs for students during a typical term of enrollment. Actual expenses vary among students depending on life styles, priorities and obligations. To assist applicants in determining their need to meet all costs of education, direct and indirect, a schedule of tuition and fee costs has been provided below with estimates of living expenses.
