SUMMARY

The Technical Welding Instructor is responsible for educating and training personnel involved with welding, support groups such as engineering, quality control and management using a combination of classroom instruction (approximately 80%) and laboratory demonstration (20%).

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ability to work a 1st shift schedule as well as 2nd shift intermittently for business needs.
- Responsible for classroom instruction of welding and welding related subjects as outlined in the various course descriptions, as well as manipulative skill instruction as needed, using the various arc welding processes.
- Prepare course materials, classrooms, and laboratories for courses.
- Update course materials as needed.
- Take inbound and make outbound telephone calls for customer needs, answer questions about class specifics, class registration, specific technical training needs, etc.
- Assist in conducting in-plant and specialized training.
- Attend various trade shows as required.
- Maintain impeccable housekeeping.
- Perform other duties as required.
- Perform Radiography, nondestructive, and destructive testing services as needed.
