## Higher Education Emergency Relief II Act - Emergency Assistance to Students

Hobart Institute of Welding Technology has been allocated \$663,262 from the U.S. Department of Education under the federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Act II (HEERF II). We were awarded \$242,943 of those funds on January 19, 2021 to be directly used as emergency assistance to students. Hobart Institute signed and returned the Certification and Agreement for the HEERF II to the Department of Education. All of the student funds have been allocated and disbursed to students.

All program students with an active enrollment as of March 31, 2021 were deemed eligible. Pell eligible students received \$1300. Non Pell eligible students received \$600. Any student who was displaced from classes due to COVID quarantine received an additional \$1000.

Students who are or could be eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, may receive emergency financial aid grants. The criteria to participate in programs Section 484 of the HEA include but are not limited to the following: U.S. citizenship or eligible noncitizen; a valid Social Security number; registration with Selective Service (if the student is male); and a high school diploma, GED, or completion of high school in an approved homeschool setting.

A total of 304 students were eligible and 302 have received this emergency assistance to help lessen the burden caused by COVID-19.
