



Coronavirus Update – March 3, 2022.

Hobart Institute of Welding Technology (the “Institute”) has been deemed as an “Essential” business by the Miami County Public Health (“MCPH”) Department www.miamicountyhealth.net. In compliance with instructions for essential business operations and guidance from MCPH, the Institute has implemented measures for the safety and health of our students, staff and community. We continue to monitor the requirements for essential businesses and will update our policies and procedures accordingly.

The Institute has implemented the following requirements effective immediately until further notice:

Staff

- Masks are recommended (regardless of vaccination status) in all classrooms unless you are alone
- Masks are recommended in meeting rooms where you are unable to maintain 6 feet social distancing
- Masks are recommended in the main office hallways and main lab areas where students are present

Students

- Masks are recommended to be worn at all times while in the classrooms locations
- Students are recommended to wear a mask when congregating in other welding booths
- Students are not required to wear a mask while in the cafeteria, but wearing a mask is recommended if you are unable to maintain a safe distance of at least 6-feet from others

The Institute will continue to monitor this rapidly changing situation and make any necessary revisions to our COVID protocols.
