Higher Education Emergency Relief Act - Emergency Assistance to Students

Hobart Institute of Welding Technology has been allocated \$2,334,719 from the U.S. Department of Education under the federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Act). We were awarded \$1,171,457 of those funds on May 13,2021 of which \$585,729 was to be directly used as emergency assistance to students. In addition, under previous disbursements of HEERF funds we were awarded \$1,149,148 of which a total of \$485,886 of those funds were directly used as emergency assistance to students. Hobart Institute signed and returned the Certification and Agreement for the HEERF funds to the Department of Education.

The first two disbursements of HEERF student funds were allocated to students in 2020 and early 2021 as noted on previous reports.

Under HEERF III, all program student new starts from April, 2021 through March 2022 with active enrollments were deemed eligible for funds. Pell eligible students received \$1800. Non Pell eligible students received \$600 - \$800. Any student who was displaced from classes due to COVID quarantine received an additional \$300 per week that they were displaced. In the 1st quarter of 2022, a total of 84 students were eligible and 84 received this emergency assistance to help lessen the burden caused by COVID-19.

In addition, we have awarded additional Emergency Financial Aid grants to students who applied for the additional grant funds and had a need due to Covid 19. Through December 31, 2021 we have awarded 11 students additional grant funds. In the 1st quarter 2022, one student received an increase in their emergency grant. Students are made aware of this additional assistance on our website and by email.

From July 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 we have awarded a total of \$353,300 of the HEERF III grant funds to students. From January 1, 2022 to March 31, 2022 we have awarded an additional \$121,400 of the HEERF III grant funds to students. Through March 31, 2022, the total of all HEERF Student funds distributed to our students was \$960,586.
